

# Agency Labor-Management Forums

- *December 31, 2010* – All forums will have identified issues, goals and metrics for reporting on a baseline
- *March 31, 2011* – Agencies will report to the Council on what their forums have chosen to measure as a baseline
- *September 30, 2011* – Forums have six-month report due to Agencies on their performance against their identified metrics
- *December 31, 2011* – Agencies will report to the Council on their forum's performance against identified metrics using the September forum reports and available updates

## §7106(b)(1) Pilot Projects (to the extent established by individual agencies)

- *December 31, 2010* – All pilots will have identified issues, goals and metrics for reporting on a baseline
- *March 31, 2011* – Pilots will report to the Council on what their forums have chosen to measure as a baseline
- *September 30, 2011* – Pilots have six-month report due to Council on their performance against their identified metrics
- *March 31, 2012* – Pilots have full year report due to Council on their forums' performance against their identified metrics

- Council is available to support efforts to measure the impact/progress of forums and pilot projects.
