

Metrics Guidelines and Deadlines

- Council guidance required agencies to report to the Council by March 31, 2011 on what their forums, or where applicable their (b)(1) pilot projects, had chosen to measure as a baseline.
- As of July 17, we have received metrics reports
 - From 38 of 51 agencies regarding forums' metrics
 - From 10 of the 12 (b)(1) pilot projects

Outstanding Metrics Reports

- Multiple follow up efforts by OPM staff
- 13 agencies have not submitted metrics reports for their agency forums
- All agencies, including the 13 agencies with outstanding metrics reports, have received additional guidance prepared by the Council
- Guidance summarizes metrics reports that have been received and includes examples of strong mission focused metrics
