

Metrics Submission Examples

Developed document with strong metric examples to distribute to:

- Agencies that have yet to report;
- Agencies that have stated they have nothing to report; and
- Agencies that need assistance in developing metrics

Delinquent Agencies

1. Set deadline for metrics submission for those agencies that have yet to submit and agencies that need assistance
 - [Possibly 1 month]
2. Plan to reach out to these agencies and providing the contact information of key personnel from the agencies with strong metrics
