Background

- Section 4(a) of E.O. 13522 provides for establishment of several pilot projects to evaluate the impact of bargaining over permissive subjects found at 5 U.S.C. 7106(b)(1)
 - 12 pilot projects established in 9 agencies covering over 14,000 bargaining unit employees
- Section 4(c) of E.O. 13522 provides that the Council submit a report to the President evaluating the results of the pilots and recommending appropriate next steps
- Report is due to the President by **May 1, 2012**

Workgroup Meetings

- Initial meeting of workgroup December 7, 2011, with follow up dialogue via e-mail during December
- Workgroup drafted proposed outline of major topics expected to be covered in report, such as
 - Background/Introduction
 - Explanation of (b)(1) bargaining and pilot selection
 - Metrics
 - Analysis of pilots
 - Conclusions and Recommendations
- Workgroup decided to gather information by interviewing representatives of pilots

Next Steps

- Schedule initial interviews with remaining pilots
- Continue analysis of initial information provided by pilots
 - All pilots must report final results **by March 31, 2012**
 - Follow up interviews may be necessary
- Provide proposed and more detailed report outline to full Council at February 15 meeting for consideration
- Provide preliminary analysis and conclusions (if any) to full Council at March 21 meeting – assumes sufficient data has been provided in advance of March 31 deadline
- Provide proposed report to full Council at April 18 meeting for consideration
